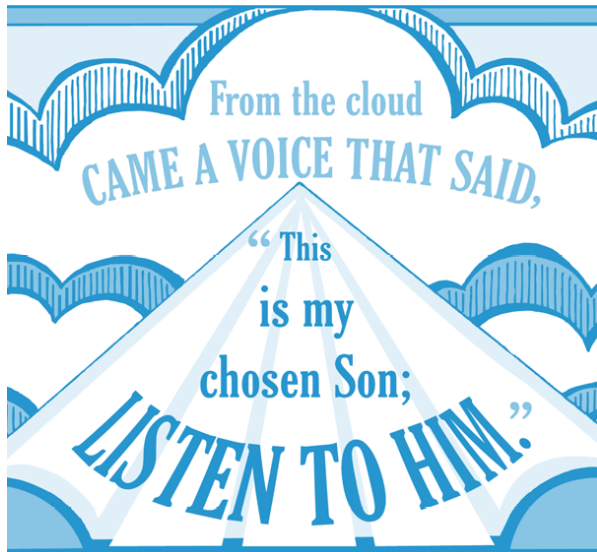

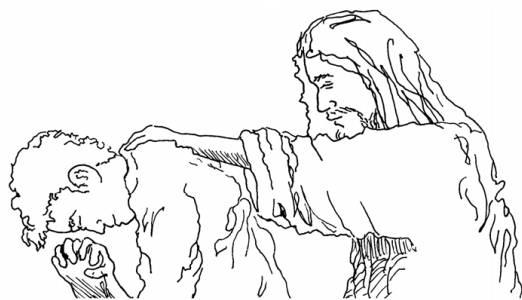

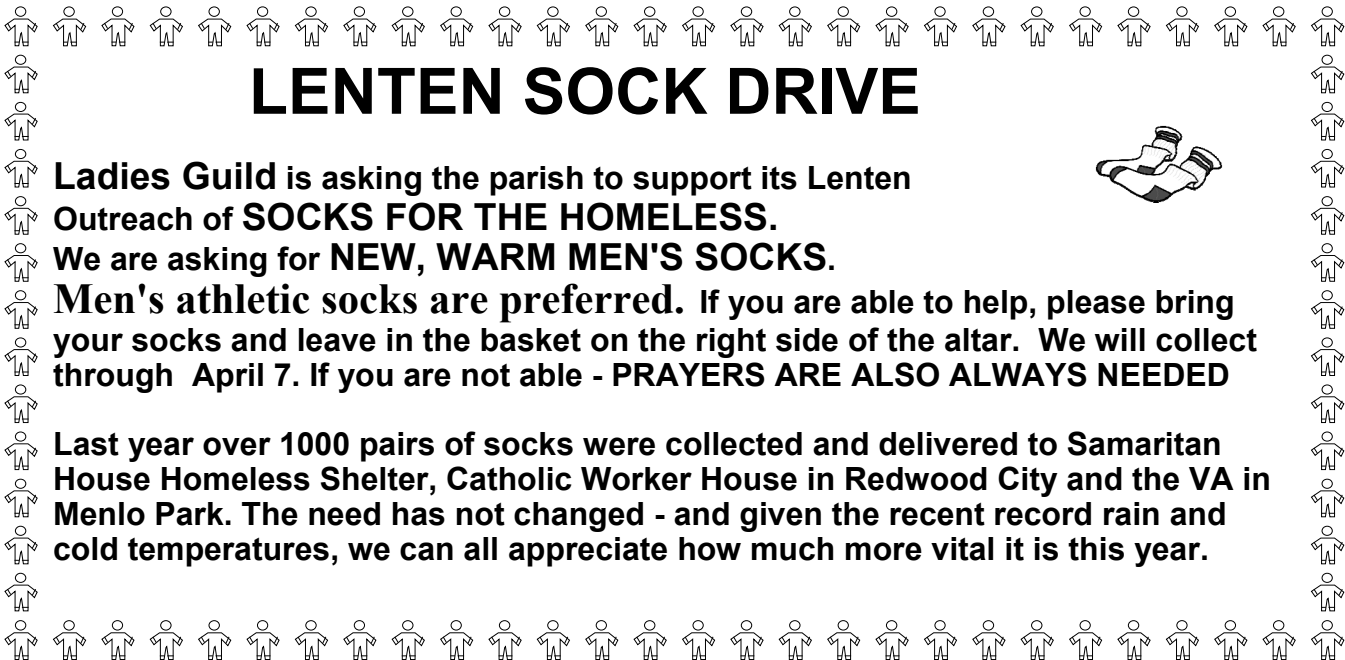
Lunch is provided; we just need to have an accurate count so please sign up on the clipboard at the back of the church this weekend.

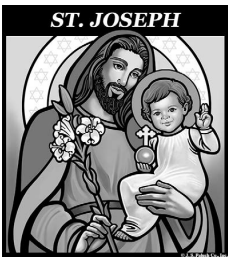
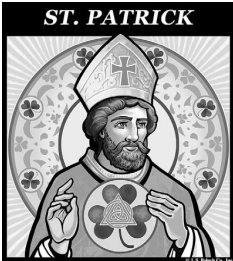

## THIS IS ST VINCENT de PAUL

Angela came to the United States from France when she was 17. She worked her way through college and graduated with an accounting degree. She then became a citizen of the USA. She and her husband lived in the South Bay, close to their work.

Angela was pregnant when her husband was deported. Financial problems necessitated that she move in with her mother in San Mateo, close to our church. Their only child, Baby Kimberly was born in October, 2018. Kimberly had health issues that required surgery at 6 weeks old. Angela continues to be at home, foregoing work to care for her child. Angela calls SVdP monthly for assistance with food and diapers.

Today Kimberly is thriving. Angela is prayerful for her daughter's improving health. When we visited their home in Feb. Angela opened the door with a warm welcome. Her bed is in the living room of this one bedroom apartment. There was Kimberly -- laying on her back wide-eyed, looking around, .....healthy. Both Angela and baby Kimberly see a bright future ahead.

This is our ministry. We visit families like Angela and Kimberly, providing a small amount of material assistance and more importantly a message of caring, hope and LOVE.
