## EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

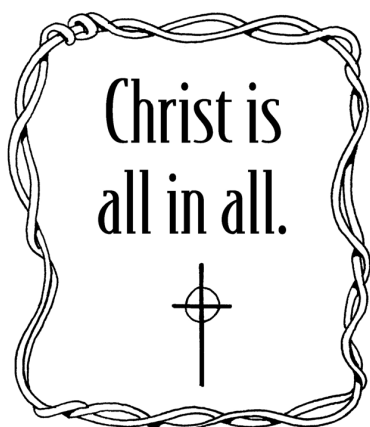
### USING OUR TIME WISELY

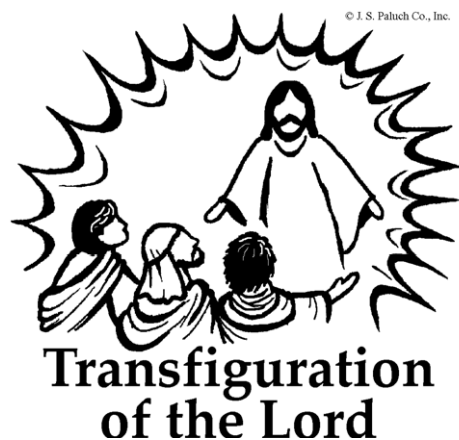
